Language training by De
Leijgraaf: a personal
approach

Every student is different and therefore learns differently. At De Leijgraaf we tailor the language training completely to the students, so that everyone can follow the lessons at their own level, at an appropriate pace. This is done as follows:

- Each student receives a personal plan
- Each student gets his or her own coach
- A computer with internet is always available during the lessons at school
- A lot of teaching material is online (to practise at home)
- We monitor the development of each participant and work together to improve the language.

What does the language training look like?

Each lesson lasts 3 hours. The teaching program is based on 3 half-days per week. You can choose to come fewer half-days per week. If the pace of a student is a bit slower or faster, we adjust the program accordingly. Doing homework is a necessary part of the process. You start with the lessons from the language level that you already master.

Lesson times:

The half-day sessions and lesson times depend on the group in which you are placed. Lessons are given at the following times:

- 09.30-12.30 am
- 13.00-4.00 pm
- 6.30 pm - 9.30 pm (only in Oss on Monday and Thursday)

What does the language training cost?

The course costs € 14 per hour. That means € 42 per half day. This includes teaching materials. You will receive a program agreement for 10 weeks, which you can extend as long as you wish to continue taking language lessons.

- 10 weeks, 3 half-days per week (90 hours) costs € 1,260.
- 10 weeks, 2 half-days per week (60 hours) costs € 840-
- 10 weeks, 1 half-day per week (30 hours) costs € 420.

Where is the training given?

Students can go to school at various places: in Cuijk, Oss and Uden. The schools are centrally located and can be easily reached by public transport.
